1. **Duc de Valmer Blanc de Blancs Brut NV** £5.00... £23.50
France (11% abv) A light, dry sparkling wine with clean, fresh, fruit flavours balanced beautifully.
2. **Prosecco Brut, Argeo, Ruggeri NV** £30.00
Italy (11% abv) A classic Prosecco with tiny bubbles, a palate of fresh green apple and a long, crisp finish.
3. **Jacquart Brut Mosaique NV** £7.95.. £40.00
Champagne (12% abv) The bouquet is fresh with pear hints mingled with intense notes of bread crust. Fresh and powerful on the palate with a long-lasting finish of spice bread and fruit flavours.
4. **Taittinger, Brut Reserve NV**..... £49.00
Champagne (12% abv) Crisp, citrus aromas with subtle toasty notes leading to an elegant, balanced palate.
5. **Jacquart Brut Mosaique Rosé NV** £55.00
Champagne (12.5% abv) A deliciously elegant, rounded, fruity style with hints of cherry and wild strawberry. Its fine streams of bubbles enhance the delicate pale pink colour. It is fresh and vibrant in style.

WHITE WINE

6. **Jacques Veritier Blanc, Vin de France 2011** £4.00... £5.50... £16.00
South West France (11% abv) The palate has a good weight of fruit and beautifully balanced acidity that gives the wine a long, fresh, crisp finish.
7. **Muscadet de Sevre et Maine sur lie V V, Château du Poyet 2011** £4.60... £6.50... £19.00
Loire, France (12% abv) Well balanced with good weight and concentration followed by a clean, crisp finish.
8. **Vermentino Vieilles Vignes IGP Pays d'Oc, Les Archères 2011** £21.50
Languedoc (12% abv) Floral, peachy and white blossom aromas are met with a creamy, well-balanced palate.
9. **Pinot Grigio, Vigneto Cantarelle, Le Vigne 2011** £5.50... £7.80... £22.50
Veneto, Italy (12% abv) Light, crisp and dry with a racy acidity that gives mouth-watering appeal. Offers good mid-palate balance with a clean finish.
10. **Favourite Son Chardonnay, Parker 2011** £24.50
Coonawarra, Australia (13.5% abv) Complex green melon and citrus peel aromas with some floral notes and very subtle vanillan oak. The creamy melon fruit continues on the palate with some floral/citrus notes.
11. **Sauvignon Blanc, Mansion House Bay 2011** £6.50... £8.95... £26.50
Marlborough, New Zealand (13% abv) A medium to full bodied wine with vibrant acidity intertwined with crisp fruits and a long and zesty finish.
12. **Gavi di Gavi DOCG, Fontanafredda 2011** £29.50
Piemonte, Italy (12.5% abv) Full and delicate, with an elegant bouquet of flowers and fruit. The palate is attractively young, dry, fresh and well-balanced.
13. **Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux 2010** £32.00
Burgundy, France (12.5% abv) Medium bodied with crisp, apple acidity, pure fruit flavours of white peaches and pears and a classic, steely, dry finish.
14. **Sancerre, Le Petit Broux, Les Celliers de Ceres 2011**..... £32.00
Loire, France (12.5% abv) Good concentration of green fruits and crisp citrus flavours with a racy, mineral streak, finishing clean and refreshing.

ROSÉ WINE

15. **Man Vintners Rosé 2010/12** £4.50... £6.50... £19.50
Western Cape, South Africa (13.5% abv) A bright cherry pink colour, with aromas of strawberries and tropical fruit. On the palate the wine is crisp and refreshing with red berry fruit flavours and a hint of sweetness.
16. **Comte de Provence Rosé, La Vidaubanaise 2011** £6.00... £8.50... £25.00
Provence, France (12.5% abv) A light, bright nose of wild strawberries with a refreshing, smooth palate. .

RED WINE

17. **Jacques Veritier Rouge, Vin de France 2011** £4.00... £5.50... £16.00
South West France (12% abv) Rich with ripe fruit character and a hint of peppery spice. The finish is well balanced and the tannins are soft and elegant.
18. **Primitivo Salento, Boheme 2011**..... £4.50... £6.25... £18.50
Puglia, Italy (13% abv) Aroma of plums and strawberry jam. Balanced on the palate without any of the excesses of alcohol which sometimes blight this variety.
19. **Malbec, Sol, Bodegas Santa Ana 2011**..... £20.00
Mendoza, Argentina (13% abv) Medium bodied and dry with soft, ripe blackcurrant flavours and balancing structure, finishing rounded and juicy.
20. **Merlot Reserva, Vina Leyda 2011** £5.50... £7.80... £23.00
Chile (14% abv) A ripe, jammy Merlot, full of accessible, warm fruits - and a classy, super smooth finish.
21. **Favourite Son Shiraz, Parker 2008** £5.50... £8.00... £23.50
Coonawarra, Australia (14.5% abv) Complex aromas of dark berry fruit and iodine notes. The palate is strong and rich with sweet earthy and complex dark fruit characters.
22. **Rioja Crianza, Vina Cerrada 2007** £6.00... £8.50... £25.00
Rioja, Spain (13.5% abv) Well structured with a good concentration of savoury, spicy fruit, well integrated oak, supple tannins and a balanced, lengthy finish.
23. **Fleurie La Bonne Dame, Jean Tête 2011** £27.50
Beaujolais, France (13% abv) Medium bodied, soft and supple, with good acidity supporting vivid forest fruit flavours. The finish is elegant, dry and poised.
24. **Pinot Noir, Trinity Hill 2011** £29.00
Hawkes bay, New Zealand (13% abv) Classic, varietal characteristics such as plums, blackcurrants and cherries are evident in this silky textured wine, entwined with earthy, smoky oak notes.
25. **Château des Gravières, Collection Prestige, Graves 2009**..... £30.00
Bordeaux, France (13% abv) Woody and toasty aromas of prunes and liquorice. Fleshy, robust and well-balanced with a firm, lengthy finish.
26. **Ser Lapo Chianti Classico Riserva, Fonterutoli 2008**..... £34.00
Tuscany, Italy (13.5% abv) Textbook Chianti Classico, with bitter Morello cherry notes and nicely taut structure.

Wines by the glass are also available in 125ml measures.
