- Prosecco Brut, Argeo, Ruggeri NV**£6.00£30.00
Italy (11% abv) A classic Prosecco with tiny bubbles, a palate of fresh green apple and a long, crisp finish.
Bellini£7.00
Prosecco topped with orange liqueur and peach juice
- Jacquart Brut Mosaïque NV**£8.00£45.00
Champagne (12% abv) The bouquet is fresh with pear hints mingled with intense notes of bread crust. Fresh and powerful on the palate with a long-lasting finish of spice bread and fruit flavours.
- Taittinger, Brut Reserve NV**.....£50.00
Champagne (12% abv) Crisp, citrus aromas with subtle toasty notes leading to an elegant, balanced palate.
- Laurent Perrier Rosé Cuvée Brut NV**£75.00
Champagne (12.5% abv) Elegant with soft, consistent bubbles, ripe red fruits such as raspberries and strawberries and a creamy textured, soft finish.

Vin de France 2013
South West France (11% abv) The palate has a good weight of fruit and beautifully balanced acidity that gives the wine a long, fresh, crisp finish.
- Muscadet de Sevre et Maine sur lie**£4.80£6.70£19.50
Vielles Vignes, Château du Poyet 2013
Loire, France (12% abv) Well balanced with good weight and concentration followed by a clean, crisp finish.
- Pinot Grigio, Vigneto Cantarelle**£5.70£8.00£23.50
Le Vigne 2013
Veneto, Italy (12% abv) Light, crisp and dry with a racy acidity that gives mouth-watering appeal. Offers good mid-palate balance with a clean finish.
- Picpoul de Pinet, Dom.Roquemolière 2013**£5.70£8.00£24.00
Languedoc Roussillon, France (12.5% abv) The wine is crisp, light and aromatic, with remarkable freshness on the palate.
- Sauvignon Blanc**
Mansion House Bay 2013£6.70£9.00£27.00
Marlborough, New Zealand (13% abv) A medium to full bodied wine with vibrant acidity intertwined with crisp fruits and a long and zesty finish.
- Gewurztraminer, Yealands 2013**.....£28.00
Marlborough, New Zealand (13% abv) An aromatic nose with notes of lychee and ginger. Elegant with a refined structure and fresh acidity on the finish.
- Gavi di Gavi DOCG, Fontanafredda 2013**.....£33.00
Piemonte, Italy (12.5% abv) Full and delicate, with an elegant bouquet of flowers and fruit. The palate is attractively young, dry, fresh and well-balanced.
- Chablis, Domaine Bernard Defaix 2013**£33.00
Burgundy, France (12.5% abv) Fruit notes of apple and melon with underlying minerality. Dry, steely and rich, with a complex finish.
- Sancerre, Le Petit Broux**
Les Celliers de Ceres 2013£33.00
Loire, France (12.5% abv) Good concentration of green fruits and crisp citrus flavours with a racy, mineral streak, finishing clean and refreshing.
- Pouilly Fuissé, Domaine Saumaize-Michelin 2013**.....£42.00
Burgundy, France (13% abv) The palate is rounded and generous with grapefruit, lemon rind notes and nutty characters.

- Ken Forrester Petit Rosé 2013/14**£4.50£6.50£19.50
Stellenbosch, South Africa (14% abv) Aromas of freshly picked strawberries, rose petal and cherry flavours. It follows through on the palate with delicious ripe raspberries with a delicate finish.
- Comte de Provence Rosé**
La Vidaubanaise 2013.....£6.20£8.70£25.50
Provence, France (12.5% abv) A light, bright nose of wild strawberries with a refreshing, smooth palate.

RED WINE

- Jacques Veritier Rouge**£4.20£5.70£17.00
Vin de France 2013
South West France (12% abv) Rich with ripe fruit character and a hint of peppery spice. The finish is well balanced and the tannins are soft and elegant.
- Primitivo Salento**£4.60£6.35£18.50
Boheme 2013
Puglia, Italy (13% abv) Aroma of plums and strawberry jam. Balanced on the palate without any of the excesses of alcohol which sometimes blight this variety.
- Saumur Rouge La Cabriole, Cave de Saumur 2012**.....£21.00
Loire, France (13% abv) This wine is delicately aromatic with a redcurrant and liquorice bouquet. Medium bodied with a firm but rounded dry finish.
- Merlot Reserva**.....£5.70£8.00£24.00
Vina Leyda 2013
Chile (14% abv) A ripe, jammy Merlot, full of accessible, warm fruits - and a classy, super smooth finish.
- Shiraz, The Stump Jump 2011**.....£5.90£8.40£25.00
South Australia (14.4% abv) Earthy, savoury characters with spice and a touch of pepper. The palate is smooth with long lasting spicy pepper, black cherry and complex fruits.
- Rioja Arienzo Crianza 2010**.....£6.20£8.70£26.00
Rioja, Spain (14% abv) Spicy aromas of sweet red berries lead to a rounded, lush palate of ripe red fruits and a firm finish.
- Malbec Corte C**.....£6.60£9.00£27.00
Vistalba 2012
Mendoza, Argentina (14% abv) Complex and vibrant with berry fruit flavours and an herby, savoury character.
- Fleurie La Bonne Dame**£28.50
Jean Tête 2013
Beaujolais, France (13% abv) Medium bodied, soft and supple, with good acidity supporting vivid forest fruit flavours. The finish is elegant, dry and poised.
- Falcon's Pearch Pinot Noir, J Lohr 2012**£30.00
Monterey, USA (13.5% abv) Aromas of cherry preserves, fresh strawberries violet and crème brûlée lead to a rich, soft palate with fine grained tannins and plenty of fruit. Acidity is clean and fresh which invites a wide range of food pairings.
- Château des Gravières, Collection Prestige**£31.00
Graves 2011
Bordeaux, France (13% abv) Aromas of black cherry complemented with brooding earthy undertones. Hints of violets and lavender lift this rich spicy palate.
- Amarone Valpolicella Valpantena DOC**.....£56.00
Villa Arvedi, Bertani 2011
Veneto, Italy (15.5% abv) Deep scents of cherry, sour cherry, berries and notes of spices. Soft in the mouth with flavours of red fruit.

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
